## Naples Botanical Garden 2017 Summer Camp

**Summer Camp Programs** (*See the next page for which weeks camps are available*)

**Wild Florida Wanderers:** For adventurous campers interested in art, exploration, and connections to the beautiful natural world around us. Get up-close and personal with a butterfly, follow marsh rabbit tracks through the garden, investigate the walking mangrove tree, and discover the natural wonders that Florida has to offer.

**Gardeners in the Kitchen:** Does your child have a green thumb? Young chefs and gardeners will follow the journey of a plant from a small seed to a meal on their plate, all while having fun. Campers will grow their own seeds, harvest a bounty of fruits and vegetables from the garden, and create their own gourmet recipes.

**Botanical Artists:** This camp caters to blossoming artists, both experienced and those just getting interested. Paint, draw, design, and more! There is no shortage of beautiful blooms, butterflies and scenery to inspire young artists at the Garden.

**Surviving Florida:** Hot, humid, and swampy: south Florida has a challenging environment. How did early people survive the harsh conditions found here? How do people in modern times survive when they're lost in the wilderness? In this exciting new camp, we'll learn about the role plants have played in helping humans. From shelter materials to tools to food and beyond, one thing is for sure: plants are not optional.

**Snacks and meals:** Healthy breakfast, lunch, and snacks are provided for children each day.

**What to wear and bring:** Campers should wear comfortable clothing suitable for outdoor activities. Close-toed shoes are required; a change of clothes is recommended. If your child needs sunscreen, be sure to apply it before camp and give it to teachers at sign-in. If your child needs prescription medication administered, please give these to the teacher at sign-in. We can only administer medications that have been prescribed to your child by a doctor.

**Rain days:** We have both indoor and outdoor activities for the campers, so camp is on rain or shine!

**Camp safety:** All of our camp teachers are experienced educators who have had background checks before the start of camp. To keep all campers safe, we cannot tolerate inappropriate behavior. Camp teachers reserve the right to dismiss a child from camp for disruptive, abusive, or inappropriate behavior.

**Pick-up/Drop-off information:** A parent or guardian must arrive between 7:50am-8:15am and between 2:45pm and 3pm each day to sign children in and out of camp. Sign-in does not begin until 8am. **We will not release a child to anyone not listed on the pick-up permission form.**

**Cancellations:** Space in each camp is limited. To give other children the opportunity to attend, please call us with as much advance notice as possible in the event that your child needs to cancel.

**Camp cost:** \$250 per child/per week for Garden members and \$300 for non-members (\$200/Member, \$240/Non-member for week of July 3-7). A 10% discount is available for registration of siblings or multiple weeks. Only one discount is available per child. Payment is due in full when you register your child for camp. 50% of the camp fee will be refunded in the event of a cancellation 10 days or fewer prior to camp start date. Cancellations after camp is in session are non-refundable.
