NAPLES, FL – March 12, 2019 – Naples Botanical Garden and the Naples Garden Club have come to the decision to cancel this year’s Naples Flower Show, which was scheduled for Friday, March 20 and Saturday, March 21. This is due to concerns regarding the coronavirus (COVID-19).
