Naples Botanical Garden Offers Resident Summer Discounts

NAPLES, FL – May 17, 2021 – Summers in Southwest Florida are best spent immersed in the beauty of our natural surroundings, which is why Naples Botanical Garden is offering discounts to residents in Collier, Lee, and Charlotte counties.

From June 1 – September 30, resident adults enjoy \$12 admission, and children ages 4 – 17 receive \$3 admission. Resident dogs receive \$8 admission during our designated dog walking times, 9 – 11 a.m. Sundays and Tuesdays. Proof of residency in the form of an ID or utility bill is required at Ticketing.

The Garden will be open 9 a.m. – 2 p.m. daily, also from June 1– September 30.
