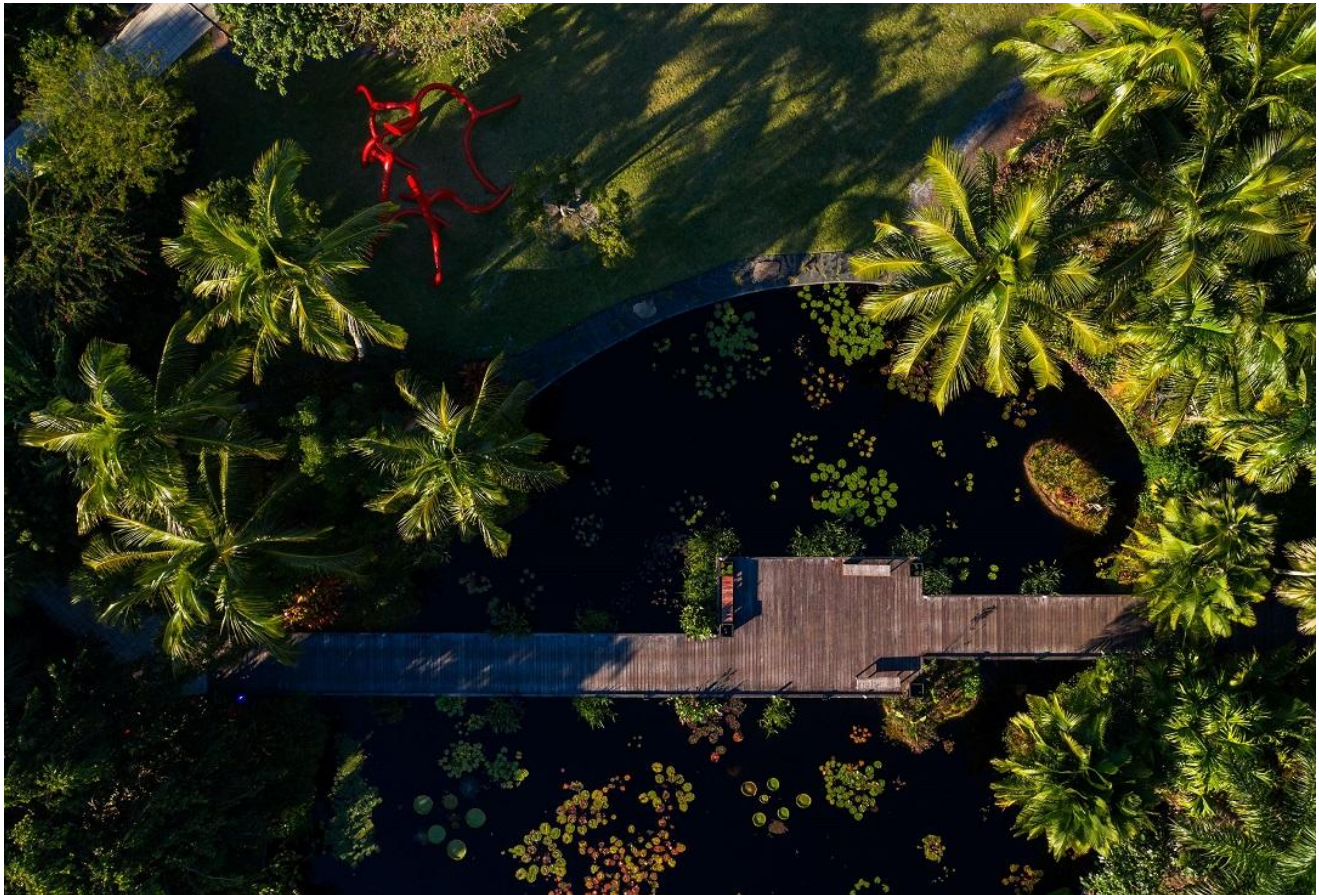

## Summer resident discounts continue through September 30

**NAPLES, FL – July 8, 2021** – Summer offers time and space for residents of Collier, Lee, and Charlotte counties to explore all that makes Southwest Florida unique. At Naples Botanical Garden, we're celebrating this time of year with discounted admission for our local residents. Through September 30, admission is \$12 for adults / \$3 for children (age 4 – 17) / \$8 for dogs (one dog per adult during designated dog walking times). As always, children 3 and under are free. Guests need only present license or proof of residency at Ticketing to receive this discount.

While here, there is no shortage of activities for visitors of all ages! Below are a few highlights for families embarking on their next Garden adventure.

- Be sure to ask for a W.O.N.D.E.R. Activity Pack next time you visit (Walk, Observe, Navigate, Draw, Explore, and Read). It contains crafts and activities designed for children around a monthly theme. July's topic: Floating Flora. Available in English and Spanish.
- Find your way to Kapnick Hall to discover *Artists in Bloom*, organized in partnership with the United Arts Council of Collier County. This exhibition offers a look into the relationship between the artist and the Garden as its muse, featuring an exciting selection of works that

reflect the essence and spirit of Naples Botanical Garden. On view through Sept. 6.
