NAPLES, FL – Feb. 7, 2022 – Seek inspiration for the present from this centuries-old art form as Naples Ikebana International #160 returns to Naples Botanical Garden Feb. 18 – 20. Now three days, this annual event is included with general admission and offers more experiences than ever before, including:

- Artistic Ikebana arrangements in Kapnick Hall
- A unique Sogetsu sculpture made with bamboo harvested from the Garden
- Ikebana demonstrations on the Performance Lawn
- W.O.N.D.E.R. family programming with a hands-on Ikebana activity
- Ginza-style market where Ikebana materials may be purchased

Naples Ikebana International #160, the local chapter of Ikebana supporters, experts, and enthusiasts, hosts the Ikebana exhibit, which offers a window into this meditative

form of flower arrangement. For many of us, modern interpretations of Ikebana serve to enhance our homes and surroundings with a touch of nature.

This year's theme, "The Joy of Reconnecting," features designs in the schools of Ikenobo, Sogetsu, Sensho Ikenobo, and Ohara. Photography of the exhibit is allowed; however, no tripods are permitted in Kapnick Hall due to high traffic.

The Ikebana exhibition is the first of the Garden's spring flower shows, with so much to see this year.
