Whether purchasing tickets online or at our ticketing windows, guests simply need to show their qualifying library card to receive this summertime perk for themselves and family members living in the same household.

Summer Resident Discount

Expanding this access to the Garden even further, from June 1 – September 30, residents of Collier, Lee, and Charlotte counties receive discounted admission to the Garden with qualifying identification. This means more space to explore this showcase of the tropical plants of the world, more opportunity to let your imagination run wild with the waves of *Sea Change*, 2021, the Garden's [*STICKWORK*](#) sculpture, and more time to soak up the intriguing world of waterlilies under the water's surface, with [*Christy Noonan: Meditations on Waterlilies*](#), on view starting July 15 in Kapnick Hall.
