On Saturday, Sept. 3 only, meet artist Christy Noonan in Kapnick Hall from 9 – 10:30 a.m., and at 10 a.m., enjoy a special hybridizing demonstration by Brandon McLane of Florida Aquatic Nurseries in the Water Garden. The weekend will be filled with demonstrations,

family-friendly activities, and special curator talks. All activities are included with Garden admission.

Residents of Collier, Lee, and Charlotte counties can enjoy Waterlily Weekend and all the Garden has to offer with discounted admission through Sept. 30, with qualifying identification.
